



Newsletter no .4 - June 2019



The 4th transnational project meeting of the CORRECT IT! project took place in Klaipeda, Lithuania on March 29th 2019. During the transnational meeting partners discussed the project activities status, about the best way to plan the events,

as well as about the finalization of the “Learning materials for face to face blended-learning obesity prevention and healthy lifestyle training course”. They also planned the elaboration of the “Methodology for VET trainers in obesity prevention and healthy lifestyle skills“. The organization of the international staff training in Italy and the first piloting of the project training materials in Norway have been also thoroughly discussed.



The Short-term joint staff training event took place in Foggia-Italy, at the UNIVERSITA DEGLI STUDI DI FOGGIA, and lasted for 5 days, 08-12 April 2019. There have been 26 participants, 4 participants from each partner organization. The international

blended-learning training course was a successful interactive training for trainers that introduced the participants into the training materials created during the project and made use of ICT, formal, informal and non-format teaching methods.

The blended mobility of VET learners in obesity prevention and healthy lifestyle skills took place in Stavanger, Norway, at the Godalen Vocational College, and lasted for 5 days, 27-31 May 2019. There have been 24 participants, 4 from each organization of the consortium, belonging to all target groups of the project – nurses, teachers, social workers. This international training course was the first piloting the VET blended learning training material, methodology and learning platform. Trainees considered it attractive, practice based and highly interactive.

Partners have organized **local workshops and conferences** at local level in



Iasi, Foggia, Portalegre, Klaipeda, Stavanger. The multiplier events of the project contributed to the efficient dissemination of the project activities, outputs and results, a well as the positive contribution on the target groups – nurses, teachers, social workers. Relevant stakeholders and VET providers were

informed on the project impact on individual and public health.

The 5th transnational project meeting and the last one of the CORRECT IT! project took place in Iasi, Romania on June 24th 2019. Each partner



organization presented the status of the project activities and the results achieved so far during the project. The local piloting of “The Blended-learning obesity prevention and healthy lifestyle training course” on 400 professionals from the target group has been planned, as well as

the organization of the local multiplier events. An action plan for providing the sustainability of the project was also drawn.
